Becoming a Foster Carer

William Campbell Foundation and South Coast Medical Service Aboriginal Corporation Permanency Support Program's supports children and young people who are unable to live at home for various reasons.

The Permanency Support Programs focus on guardianship, family restoration and long term foster care.

Together we aim to lower the number of children placed into out of home care in NSW. We will work together with a strong focus on the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander (ATSI) Placement Principles in ensuring Aboriginal children and young people are supported culturally. Children and young people have the right to grow up being connected to their culture.

Both agencies provide 24/7 after hours support, a generous tax free allowance, regular home visits, ongoing professional training and a dedicated caseworker.

Our Partnership Artwork

Our Partnership Artwork depicts the collaboration between both agencies working together to better support Aboriginal children, young people and families.

This artwork was created by young people from both agencies at our joint Living Skills and Cultural Support Programs. The young people created pictures and drawings that depicted what collaboration meant to them.
